1. **Welcome new and alumni choristers!!** 1 rehearsal completed – 12 remaining.
2. **Weekly, choristers should:** Sign in on the attendance roster, pick up a rehearsal bulletin + handouts, and be in place on time at 7:29 p.m. Thank you!
3. **NEW! SA / TB Sectionals: Sectionals begin TONIGHT and go for 3 weeks.**
4. **NEW! Reference recording:** Sign up at the registration table if you want a reference recording of the anthems.
5. **NEW! Lamb of God:** Our 10<sup>th</sup> anthem is on its way and will be distributed next week.
6. **NEW! Memorization:** There is good news and bad news! We will NOT memorize our entire season of repertoire. We WILL memorize a few. Anthems memorized will be announced soon.
7. **NEW! Join the Chorus Google Group:** Here choristers can contact other members, learn names, start discussions, create pages, or view/share files. At the registration table is a copy of “How to Use Our Google Groups.” Not a Google Group member yet? Inform our webmaster, Colin Lim, (see email below) and he will send you an invitation to join. Get connected!!
8. **NEW! Seating Chart:** A seating chart will be used to best group singers within each section. The seating chart will be posted after registration has closed 4 February. Please leave your name card **IN YOUR SEAT** after each rehearsal. Choristers are NOT at liberty to move seating cards amongst themselves for the placements are allocated to project the best sounds from the chorus as a whole. There may be some adjustments so please be patient.
9. **Season vital information:** Is on the registration table for your reference.
10. **Number measures:** Please number measures in all scores by 4 February.
11. **Rehearsal attendance:** Choristers are expected to faithfully attend all (100%) rehearsals. Exceptions may be for travel or sickness and then singers will **notify section leader and conductor (see below) in advance of absence.** Notification of absence demonstrates courtesy, responsibility and respect. Singers absent too often from rehearsals will forfeit their place in the Chorus for the season.

13. **Chorus calendar online:** Our Google Groups now has our rehearsal schedule included. Changes will always be posted to the online calendar and notified here in the rehearsal bulletin.
14. **Pencils & score markings:** Choristers must mark their scores. Bring a pencil to every rehearsal.
15. **Performance attire:** For new choristers, a fashion coordinator will view and approve the ladies attire advance of the concert. Those without specified attire will not be approved to sing. Attire for men and women is explained on the season rehearsal schedule document.
16. **Bless God:** Please keep this song in your folder. We will refer to it throughout the season.

19. **Black folders:** All singers must use the same black folder for the presentation. Folders will be distributed prior to the concert and are to be returned at the end of the season. Lost files chargeable at \$15 per file. Files can be purchased for \$15.00 at the registration table.
  
20. **No Fragrances please!** When we request ‘no perfumes, colognes, lotions or fragrances’ please take it seriously. Such fragrances cause mucus membranes in the nose, sinuses, and throat to swell and secrete.
